

## Upgrading your HL129EW's Firmware

### STEP 1: Downloading the Firmware from Aztech Website

- Using your PC, open a web browser and go to [www.aztech.com](http://www.aztech.com).
- Click on Categories>Aztech Datacom.
- From the Aztech Datacom Page, Click on HomePlug.
- Select HL129EW from the HomePlug Page.
- In the HL129EW page, scroll down the page, click on Downloads>Firmware.
- Click on the latest firmware available.
- The firmware file will be saved as a zip file. Remember to unzip the file to access the firmware file.

NOTE: It is important to only use official released Aztech Firmware

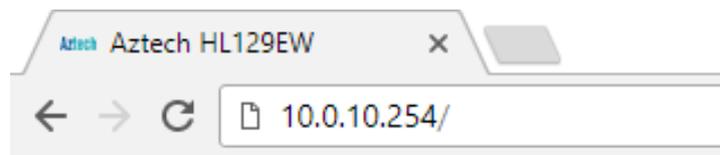
### STEP 2: Initial Setup

To upgrade your firmware, ensure to connect a PC to your HL129EW via Ethernet Cable.



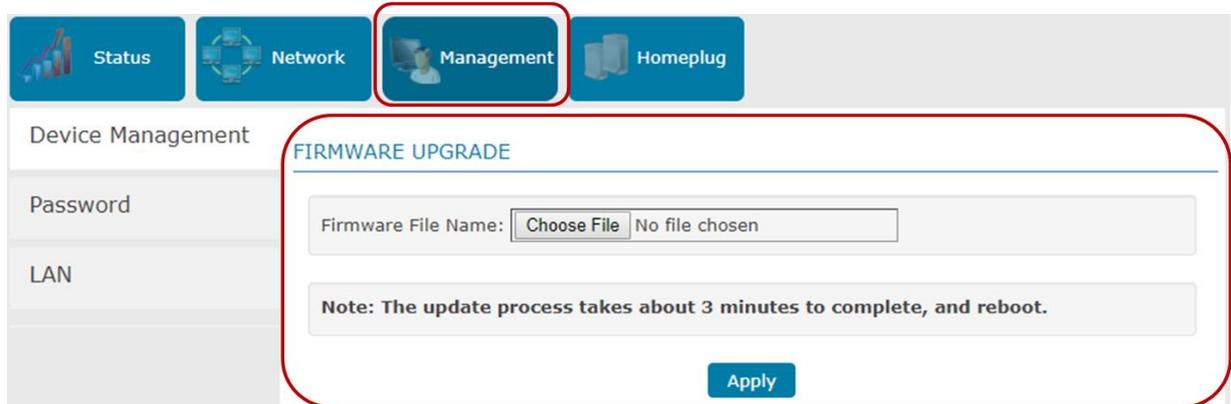
### STEP 3: Accessing HL129EW Web User Interface

Launch any web browser (Safari, Chrome, Internet Explorer, Microsoft Edge or Mozilla Firefox) and key in **10.0.10.254** in the address bar to access the HL129EW web user interface.



## STEP 4: Accessing Firmware Upgrade Page

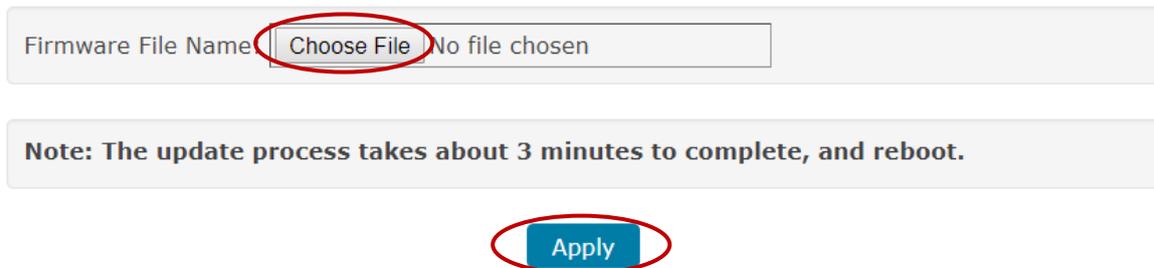
On the Web User Interface, click on **Management**. You will be redirected to **Management>Device Management**. From this page, you will see the Firmware Upgrade section.



## STEP 5: Uploading Firmware File

Click the **Choose File** button and locate the firmware upgrade file you have downloaded from the Aztech Support Site. You may then click the **Apply** button to confirm and start the firmware upgrade process.

NOTE: It will take approximately 3 mins for the upgrade to complete. It will then follow by a reboot.

## STEP 6: Firmware Upgrade Complete

Once the firmware upgrade is complete, you will be redirected to the Web User Interface's Homepage.



It is highly recommended to perform a factory reset to ensure that all new updates are successfully applied. To do this, simply press the Reset button of your HL129EW for 4 seconds.

## STEP 7: Confirming if firmware upgrade is successful

To confirm if the firmware upgrade process is successful, click on **Status** where you will see the **Device Info**. Check the **Firmware Version**. The **Firmware Version** number should match the **latest** Firmware Version number available online.
